# OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES AND TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR THE "KENO GAMES CONTEST" FROM THE ATLANTIC LOTTERY CORPORATION

The "KENO GAMES CONTEST" is sponsored by Atlantic Lottery Corporation ("ALC") and provides alc.ca players with a chance to win one (1) of three (3) cash prizes of \$5,000.

From November 1st to November 13th, 2024, every \$10 wagered on select games, on alc.ca and/or the Atlantic Lottery app, on each day of the contest (see eligible games below) will earn the player one (1) automatic entry into the contest. To earn entries, players must have a valid, active and funded alc.ca account, be nineteen (19) years or older and be a resident of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick or Newfoundland and Labrador.

**Note:** Casino games are not offered in Prince Edward Island and residents of Prince Edward Island are not eligible to enter the Contest.

# **CONTEST PERIOD**

The "KENO GAMES CONTEST" will take place from November 1st, 2024, at 00:00:00 AT to November 1sth, 2024, at 23:59:59 AT (Contest Period).

## **HOW TO PARTICIPATE**

During the Contest Period, every \$10 wagered on select games, on alc.ca and/or the Atlantic Lottery app, on each day of the contest (see eligible games) will earn the player one (1) automatic entry into the draw for a chance to win. Players can earn a maximum of one hundred (100) entries per day during the contest period.

Potential winners will have seven (7) days to provide their information once an ALC representative has contacted them via email. No purchase is necessary to enter this contest. See below for more details.

## **ELIGIBLE GAMES**

The following Casino games on alc.ca and/or the Atlantic Lottery app can be played to earn entries into the contest:

#### **RANDOM DRAW AND ODDS**

During the contest period, participants have a chance to win one (1) of three (3) cash prizes of \$5,000.

The odds of winning the prize will depend upon the total number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period. All draws adhere to the draw procedures established for the draw by Atlantic Lottery.

On Friday November 15, 2024 (or as soon as possible thereafter) a random draw will be conducted for the contest from all eligible entries received during the contest period (November 1st at 00:00:00AM AT to November 13th at 23:59:59PM AT.)

If the potential winner has not contacted ALC within seven (7) days of being contacted, ALC shall have the right to disqualify the potential winner and draw an alternate winner for the same prize. ALC shall be fully and completely released and discharged from any liability or responsibility in this regard. Government issued photo identification must be provided for proof of identification and age. If the winner is under the age of 19, they will be disqualified and an alternate winner for the same prize will be drawn.

Prize package is non-transferable.

An entrant can win only one (1) prize.

# **ELIGIBILITY**

This contest is open to residents of New Brunswick, Newfoundland and Labrador and Nova Scotia\*\*; who are nineteen (19) years of age or older, with the exception of employees of ALC or any immediate family of the aforementioned. 'Immediate Family' means the spouse, sibling, parent and/or child of an employee referred to above who resides with that employee.

Please note: Any individual who has falsified their registration information will be ineligible to receive their prize upon winning.

By wagering \$10 on the Eligible Games during the Contest Period as per these official rules, players consent to entering the contest. If a player does not wish to enter the contest, they can choose not to wager \$10 on the Eligible Games during the Contest Period.

No purchase is necessary to enter. Eligible entrants can obtain a no purchase entry ("No Purchase Entry") by sending a request in writing, including: (a) the entrant's first and last name, and valid email address associated to the entrant's alc.ca account; (b) a 200-word unique essay describing why they would want to win a prize by mailing the request (in an envelope with sufficient Canadian postage) to: Atlantic Lottery Corporation – KENO GAMES CONTEST, P.O. Unique essays that are photocopied or otherwise produced or reproduced by mechanical or electronic means and/or that are not reasonable, unique, and original are void. No Purchase Entry Requests must be received by ALC no later than November 14th at 4pm AT. ALC is not responsible for

delayed or no delivery of any No Purchase Entry Request. Players can earn a maximum of one hundred (100) No Purchase Entries per day during the Contest Period. Players must have an active alc.ca member account created prior to sending the request.

\*\*Please Note: Casino games are not offered in Prince Edward Island and residents of Prince Edward Island are not eligible to enter the Contest.

#### **DELIVERY OF PRIZES**

ALC will attempt to contact the potential winner within one (1) business day after the draw (or as soon as possible thereafter). If ALC is not able to contact the potential winner after seven (7) days after the initial attempt, ALC shall have the right to disqualify the potential winner, and the entry drawn immediately after the disqualified entry for the prize will be eligible to win the prize that otherwise would have been awarded for the previously selected entry.

Government issued photo identification must be provided for proof of identification and age. If the winner is under the age of nineteen (19), they will be disqualified, and the next potential winner will be contacted. Winners will be notified by phone or email.

Winner must provide the completed release form issued by ALC, proof of identification and payment option form in person or via scanner or fax machine within seven (7) days of being contacted; failure to do this will result in the winner waiving his/her right to the prize. The release form and prize form must be completed before any prize is issued by ALC.
