

Blackjack Lucky Lucky™, Lucky Ladies™ and Buster Blackjack™

INTRODUCTION

- Blackjack Lucky Lucky™, Lucky Ladies™ and Buster Blackjack™ is a Blackjack casino game where you play against the house to try and obtain a hand with a value which is greater than that of the dealer, without going over 21. Included are three optional and very popular side bets that can be played on each hand. The largest potential win for each side bet is 500x for Lucky Lucky™, 100x for Lucky Ladies™ and 2,000x for Buster Blackjack™.

CARDS

- This game is played with an 8-deck shoe where each deck consists of 52 cards. The entire shoe is played until the cutting card has been drawn. Aces count as 1 or 11 (player's choice). Kings, Queens, Jacks, and Tens count as 10. The 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2 cards are counted at their face values.

TYPE OF HANDS

INITIAL HAND

- The first two cards dealt to a betting spot together are called an initial hand.

SOFT HAND

- A soft hand is a hand that has an Ace that can be counted as 1 or 11. For instance, a hand that is composed of an 8 and an Ace is called a Soft 19 because the hand can be played with a total of 9 or 19.

HARD HAND

- A hard hand is a hand that can be counted with the face value of each card and if there is an Ace card, the Ace is counted as 1. For instance, a hand that is composed of a 10-value card, a 6-value card and an Ace card is called a Hard 17 because the Ace can be counted only as 1 otherwise it will exceed 21.

BUSTED HAND

- A hand that has a hard count exceeding 21 and is no longer eligible for that game round.

BLACKJACK

- If the initial hand is an Ace with any 10-value card (10, Jack, Queen or King), that hand is called a Blackjack.

NEW SHOE AND CARD SHUFFLE

- When a new shoe is required, the game displays a brief animation of the cards being shuffled. You may then cut the shoe by dragging and moving the cutting card within the allowed cutting zone.
- The shoe will be cut in half in the location where you place the cutting card. Subsequently both halves will be placed one behind the other and a new cutting card slides back in at exactly the 50% mark, completing the shoe cutting process.
- The shoe is then played until the cutting card has been drawn, at which point the dealer will place it on the table and finish out the current round. Once the round is finished, the dealer proceeds with shuffling the cards and starting a new shoe.
- You can manually start a new shoe by selecting the option in the game settings.

HOW TO BET

- Select your bet amount by clicking on the chip selector and then on the desired chip. Place a chip on the table by clicking on any of the available betting spots on the table. The value of the chip will be displayed next to it. Continue until the total amount that you wish to bet (within the minimum and maximum table limits) is displayed on the table. If you make a mistake, you may click on UNDO (to undo the last action) or CLEAR (to remove all bets on the table).
- You may play on one or multiple hands per game. All side bets are optional on each hand and become available only after you have placed a bet on the base game betting spot.
- NOTE: At the end of each game, you may place a new bet for the next game or click on REBET to place the same bet as in the previous game.

HOW TO PLAY

- To begin, place your desired bet and then click on DEAL.
- Two cards are dealt to you face up for each betting spot on which you have placed a bet. Each hand is played separately, with game buttons indicating which hand is in play. The dealer is dealt a first card face up and a second one face down.
- If the dealer's face up card is an Ace, the dealer will offer you an Insurance bet. See Insurance bet section for more details.
- If the dealer's face up card is a 10 or a face card, the dealer will check (peek) their face down card to verify if he has a Blackjack or not. If the

dealer has a Blackjack, the dealer will flip and reveal their face down card. All hands in play are losing hands, except if your hand is a Blackjack, which will be a push (your stake is returned).

- If the dealer does not have a Blackjack, the game will carry on, and depending on the value of your hands, you will be offered the following options for each hand in play:

HIT

- Draw another card by clicking on the HIT button.

STAND

- Keep your hand as is by clicking on the STAND button.
- NOTE: If the value of one of your hands is a HARD 21, STAND will automatically be selected for you.

DOUBLE DOWN

- You may choose to double your initial bet on any hand if it is composed of only two cards and if the hand is not a Blackjack. When you Double Down your bet, the game will automatically place an additional bet, which will be the same amount as your initial bet, and you will receive only one card.

SPLIT

- If your first two cards have the same value, you can split them and play each of them as a separate hand. When you choose Split, the game will automatically place an additional bet which will be the same amount as your initial bet. The dealer will deal a second card to your split hand. You will complete your play for the first split hand before moving to the next one.
- NOTE: You may split up to 3 times for each hand in play.

SPLITTING ACES

- When you split Aces, you will be dealt only one additional card on each Ace and your hand will STAND automatically. The game will automatically place an additional bet which will be the same amount as your initial bet. If you are then dealt a 10 or a face card, your hand is counted as HARD 21 but is not considered a Blackjack.

DOUBLING DOWN AFTER SPLITTING

- Once you split and receive a second card, you can Double Down on your initial bet.

LATE SURRENDER

- Surrender allows you to forfeit your hand and lose only half of your bet, but only after the dealer has drawn cards and checked for blackjack.

INSURANCE SIDE BET

- If the dealer's face up card is an Ace, you can insure your hand by paying for an insurance bet. Two buttons will appear on your active hand, asking whether or not you wish to insure that hand. You must answer that question, in sequence, for each hand in play. If you choose to insure a hand, the insurance bet amount is half of your initial bet on this hand and is placed automatically. The dealer then checks their face down card to see if he has a Blackjack.
- If the dealer has a Blackjack, you lose your initial bet on that hand but win 2 to 1 on your insurance bet. If the dealer does not have a Blackjack, you lose your insurance bet on the hand and the game continues.

EVEN MONEY

- If any of your hands are a Blackjack hand, you have the option of taking EVEN MONEY instead of buying Insurance.
- Even Money pays 1 to 1 your initial bet instead of the regular Blackjack payout which is 3 to 2. If you choose Even Money, the dealer will pay your initial bet 1 to 1 and the game ends for that hand. If you refuse Even Money, the game will carry on and the Dealer will verify if their hand is a Blackjack hand or not.
- If the dealer has a Blackjack, your Blackjack hand will be a push. If the dealer does not have a Blackjack, your Blackjack hand will be paid the regular Blackjack payout which is 3 to 2.

HOUSE STRATEGY

- In Blackjack Lucky Lucky™, Lucky Ladies™ and Buster Blackjack™, the dealer stands on any 17.
- NOTE: If one of your hands goes over 21 (busts), you lose the stakes on both the initial bet plus any side bets on that hand. If you have no other hands in play, the dealer is not required to play out the hand and will turn over their face down card and the game automatically ends.

PAYOUTS FOR WINNING HANDS

- Your hand wins if it:
 - Totals 21 or less and beats the dealer's hand;
 - Totals 21 or less and the dealer goes over 21 (busts);
 - Is a Blackjack and the dealer's hand is not a Blackjack.

- A winning hand (a regular winning bet) pays 1 to 1 on the initial bet. A Blackjack pays 3 to 2. An insurance bet pays 2 to 1. When totals are identical (a 'push'), you recover your initial bet. Doubling down bet pays 1 to 1.

SIDE BETS

- On each hand there are 3 side bets available to play:
 - Lucky Lucky™
 - Lucky Ladies™
 - Buster Blackjack™
- These side bets are optional and only become available once a standard Blackjack bet has been placed on the corresponding hand. You can choose any combination of side bets to bet on that you desire; you can bet on 1, 2, or all 3 side bets.
- The Lucky Lucky™ and Lucky Ladies™ side bets will be settled right after the initial draw, with the Lucky Lucky side bet being settled first. The Buster Blackjack™ side bet shall be resolved once all hands have been settled.
- If a side bet is a losing bet, the Dealer will simply remove the bet from the table. If a side bet is a winning bet, the Dealer will return the bet on the table to you and pay you the appropriate amount.

LUCKY LUCKY™ SIDE BET

- The Lucky Lucky™ Side Bet is based on the Dealer's up-card and your initial two cards to form a 3-card poker hand. If the created 3-card poker hand is a hand on the Lucky Lucky™ Side Bet payable, you win the corresponding multiplier and you will be paid accordingly. See the Lucky Lucky™ Side Bet payable:

Hands	Description	Pays
Suited 777	Three sevens of the same suit	500x
Suited 678	A six, seven, and eight of the same suit	200x
777	Three sevens of different suits	100x
678	A six, seven, and eight of different suits	25x
Suited 21	Three cards of the same suit that equal 21 in value	15x
21	Three cards that equal 21 in value	3x
20	Three cards that equal 20 in value	2x
19	Three cards that equal 19 in value	1x

- If the hand qualifies for more than one win, you will only be paid the highest value win in the payable. Any other 3-card poker hand formed that is not in the payable is a losing hand.

LUCKY LADIES™ SIDE BET

- The Lucky Ladies™ Side Bet is based on your initial hand (first two cards). If your initial hand is a hand on the Lucky Ladies™ Side Bet payable, you win the corresponding multiplier and you will be paid accordingly. See the Lucky Ladies™ Side Bet payable:

Hands	Description	Pays
Queen of Hearts Pair	Two Queen of Hearts	100x
Matched 20	Two 10's, Jacks, Queens, or Kings of the same suit	25x
Suited 20	Two cards of the same suit that equal 20 in value	10x
Any 20	Two cards that equal 20 in value	3x
One Queen of Hearts	One Queen of Hearts	2x
One Queen	One Queen of any suit	1x

- If the hand qualifies for more than one win, you will only be paid the highest value win in the payable. Any other hand that is not in the payable is a losing hand.

BUSTER BLACKJACK™ SIDE BET

- The Buster Blackjack™ Side Bet is based on the Dealer's hand, and whether or not they will go bust. This side bet will remain active until the dealer reveals their hand. The result of one or both of your hands does not matter.
- Once all hands have been played, the Dealer will draw cards following the usual house strategy. If the Dealer busts, you win the side bet and will be paid according to the payable. If the Dealer does not bust, you lose the side bet. See the Buster Blackjack™ Side Bet payable:

Number of Cards in Dealer's Busted Hand Pays	
8 or More	250x
7	50x
6	18x
5	4x
3 or 4	2x

- If your hand on which you have placed a Buster Blackjack™ side bet is a Blackjack, and the Dealer goes bust with seven or more cards, you will be paid according to this payable instead:

Number of Cards in Dealer's Busted Hand Pays	
8 or More	2000x
7	800x

TERMS AND RETURN TO PLAYERS

- In the event of a game in real play being interrupted, (i.e. started but not completed due to connectivity issues or accidentally closing the browser, etc.), depending on the previous state of the game, it will either resume from the point of the last draw, or display the outcome of the game already in play. Any winnings will be correctly credited to your account and will be exact, according to the result prior to the game being interrupted.
- In the event of a non-responsive game or problem during a bonus round, the game will repeat the incomplete game and display the result to you when you next launch the game.
- The odds of getting a particular outcome are always the same at the start of every game. The odds do not vary based on prior outcomes, bet size, balance size, time of day, day of the week, etc. For example, if the top award is won on a given play of the game, the chance of winning the top award on the next play is exactly the same. Likewise, prior game losses do not influence or change future games in any way.
 - Based on an optimal player strategy, the Blackjack base game has a theoretical Return to Players (RTP) of 99.68%.
 - The RTP for the optional Lucky Lucky™ side bet is 93.10%.
 - The RTP for the optional Lucky Ladies™ side bet is 94.68%.
 - The RTP for the optional Buster Blackjack™ side bet is 93.90%
- Malfunction voids all pays and plays.

Menu

Home

The home button returns you to the casino lobby.

Pay table

Within the game menu, press the "i" icon to view pay table and game information.

Help

Within the game menu, the "?" icon opens the game's help file.

Sound / Music

Use the sound option to mute or enable all game sounds. Where applicable, you can use the music option to turn off just the background music, while leaving other game sounds on.

Other

Please note, the performance of your network or devices (e.g. the speed of your connection or processor) may have, or may appear to have, an effect on the game such as in making decisions where speed is a factor or the update of progressive jackpot values.

If a bet has been placed and remains unsettled after 90 days, it will become void and be forfeited to charity.
